CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Riverlakes Pro Shop is in charge of all competition play on the course and reserves the right to alter the program or method of play at any time.

All play is governed by the Rules of Golf and the Regulations as set out in this book and as they appear of the Local Rules card or notices.

COMPETITIONS – MEN

A Grade – Handicap 12 and less

B Grade – 13 – 18 Inclusive

C Grade – 19 – 36 inclusive

COMPETITIONS – LADIES

A Grade – Handicap 18 and less

B Grade – 19 and above

Number of players required both in Men's and Women's competition:

1 Grade – 8 to 29

2 Grades – 30 to 59

3 Grades – 60 and over

4 BALL & AMBROSE COMPETITIONS

All players (teams) compete in one division.

2026 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The General Conditions of Play detailed on the Local Rules Card apply in full. The Proshop will manage the championships and alter the conditions of play as deemed necessary. The Proshop's decision shall be final.
2. The Championships will be played over 72 holes (4 x 18-hole rounds) of stroke play from the blue tees for Men and the red tees for Ladies. **Round 1 is scheduled for Saturday, 9th May and then continues on Saturday 16th May, Saturday 23rd May and Saturday 30th May.**
3. To qualify for participation in the Club Championships, a member must have played a minimum of 5 Riverlakes Competition Golfink events during the preceding 12 months, independent of the Honour Board Events.
4. **All 4 Rounds must be paid for before teeing off in the first round.**
5. All players must be current 7-day members of Riverlakes Golf at the time of the Championships and must also hold a current GA handicap.
6. Divisions for the Club Championships are:
Men: A Grade: 0 – 12
B Grade: 13 – 18
C Grade: 19 – 36
Ladies: A Grade: 0 - 18 B Grade: 19+

Junior: Under 18 years as at 9th May 2026.

7. The best aggregate, gross score in each grade will decide the respective Grade Champions. The lowest, aggregate, gross score over the 72 holes will also become the Club Champion for that year.
8. If a tie occurs in all Gross events a sudden death playoff will commence from the 1st hole, playing the course in normal order until there is a winner. In the event of a tie for all other events, a count back shall be conducted according to the rules of golf.
9. For the Nett Championship event, the player's daily handicap at the start of the 1st round will be used to as a frozen handicap for all four rounds to determine the nett winner in each grade. For the events played in conjunction with the Championships players use their daily handicap for that particular day.
10. Gross Champions and Runners-Up for each grade are also eligible for the Nett Championship for that grade.
11. The Junior Championship will be played over 36 holes in conjunction with the first two rounds of the Club Championships. Prizes will be awarded to the gross and nett winner/s. Junior Champions are also eligible to win other Club Championships.
12. Any dispute must be presented to the Proshop within twenty minutes of the last group completing their round for that day. Disputes and decisions shall be governed by rules 20.2.
13. The 3rd and 4th rounds will include a seeded draw. The players with the best 8 aggregate, gross scores in each grade at the end of 2nd and 3rd rounds will be allotted tee times at the end of the field for the next week. In the event of a tie a count back will be used to determine the 8 players to be included in this draw.
14. It is the responsibility of the player to know their tee time if they are included in seeded draws in Rounds 3 & 4 of the championships.
15. Any player included in the seeded draw must play at the allocated time to be eligible for the Gross Championship. If the seeded player does not play at that time, they cannot win the Gross Winner or Gross Runners-up prize. They will be eligible for the Nett championship prize and the Matchplay Championship event.
16. The best 8 gross scores in each grade - A, B, C and best 8 Nett scores for Ladies - will qualify for the Matchplay Championships. In the event of a tie a countback shall be conducted according to the rules of golf.
17. In the event of a player or players being unable to commit to playing on the dates set for all 3 rounds of the Match play Championships, the next lowest gross scores from the Club Championships will be used to fill the vacancy or vacancies.
18. Once the Matchplay draw is finalised, no changes to the draw will be permitted. If any player cannot fulfill their match they will forfeit the game with their opponent going to the next round.
19. The use of motorised carts and distance finding devices is allowed.

2026 MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Men's Match Play Championships are open to the players with the **8 best gross scores** attained in the Club Championships in **each of A, B and C Grades**.
2. The Ladies Match Play Championship is open to the players with the **8 best nett scores** attained in the Club Championships in **A and B Grades combined**.
3. **The 2026 Match Play Championships will be played on the 6th June, 13th June and 22st June 2026.**
4. In the event of a player or players being unable to commit to playing on the dates set for all 3 rounds of the Match Play Championships, the Proshop will substitute the next lowest gross score from the Club Championships for men and nett for women to fill the vacancy or vacancies.
5. The General Conditions of Play detailed in the Local Rules Card apply in full. The Proshop shall have the power to manage the Championships and alter the conditions of play as deemed necessary. The Proshop's decision will be final.
6. All players must be 7-day financial members of the Riverlakes Golf at the time of the Championships and must hold a current GA handicap.
7. Players must play each round of the Match Play Championships at the time stipulated by the Proshop.
8. If a player arrives at the 1st tee, ready to play, up to five minutes after the starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification. The Proshop will consider circumstances that may warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in the Rule 20.
9. **For each grade of the Men's Match Play Championships no handicap is used.**
10. **The final for all grades of the Men's Match Play Championships will be played over 36 holes.**
11. In The Men's event if there is a tie after 36 holes have been played then the match is extended by as many holes as required for the match to be won. Play is to continue from the first hole.
12. **The Ladies' final will be played over 18 holes.**
13. **For the Ladies Match Play Championships, the daily handicap is used.** The current handicap applies and the number of strokes given is the difference. Where the difference of the handicap exceeds 18, players may receive 2 or more strokes per hole where applicable. The Ladies Match Play Index will be used to determine where the strokes are given.

14. If there is a tie after 18 holes have been played then the match is extended by as many holes as required for the match to be won. Play is to continue from the first hole. Handicap will be used for extra holes.
15. If a doubt or dispute arises between the players, a player may make a claim. The Proshop may consider a claim only if the player making the claim notifies their opponent, they are making a claim, the facts of the situation and that they want a ruling. If no duly authorised representative of the Proshop is available within a reasonable time, the players must continue the match without delay.
16. A claim must be made before any player in the match plays from the next teeing ground or, in the case of the last hole of the match, before both players of the match leave the putting green.
17. The Proshop may not consider a later claim unless it is based on facts previously unknown to the player making the claim and they have been given wrong information by their opponent.
18. Once the result of the Match has been officially announced, a later claim may not be considered by the Proshop unless it is satisfied that the opponent knew they were giving the wrong information.
19. The use of motorised carts and distance finding devices is allowed.

2026 LONE WOLF CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Lone Wolf Championship is an individual handicap Matchplay competition.
2. The Qualifying round for the Lone Wolf will be held in conjunction with the Monthly Medal competition on Saturday 1st August 2026.
3. To qualify for participation in the Lone Wolf, a member must have played a minimum of 5 Riverlakes Competition Golflink events during the preceding 12 months, independent of the Honour Board Events.
4. MEN: The best 32 nett scores qualify for the Championship
5. LADIES: The best 8 nett scores qualify for the Championship
6. Players wishing to qualify must mark their card with a 'Q.' Players must be able to play on all dates indicated below to avoid forfeits.
7. Cards not marked with a 'Q' will be ineligible.
8. Should there be a tie for qualifying positions a countback will be used to determine the players who qualify.
9. After the qualifying round a seeded draw will be conducted. After the draw is made no replacement players will be allowed.
10. Games must be played on the dates indicated below

12. Matches are handicap Matchplay, played off the daily handicap on the day of the match.
20. If there is a tie after 18 holes have been played then the match is extended by as many holes as required for the match to be won. Play is to continue from the first hole. Handicap will be used for extra holes.

2026 FOURSOMES CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All players must be 7-day financial members of Riverlakes Golf at the time of the championships and must also hold a current GA handicap.
2. To qualify for participation in the Foursomes Championship, a member must have played a minimum of 5 Riverlakes Competition Golflink events during the preceding 12 months, independent of the Honour Board Events.
3. Teams are to be made up of two players of the same gender.
4. The Championships are to be held over 27 holes to be played on Saturday, 18th July 2026.
5. One player in each team is nominated to tee off on the first hole and the foursome pair then alternate tee shots up to and including the 18th hole.
6. On the 19th tee, the players change the order of play so that the player who had teed off on the 1st hole for the first 18 holes now tees off on the 2nd and the remaining even numbered holes. This change is mandatory. Failure to do this will cause the team to be disqualified from the competition.
7. In the event of a penalty, e.g., ball in hazard, the order of play does not change. If Player A hit the ball into the hazard, then Player B will play the next shot.
8. In the event of a tie, the Gross Championship will be decided by a "sudden death" playoff, starting at the 1st hole, followed by the 2nd hole etc. The order of play will be as per the first 18 holes. The Nett Championship will be decided by a countback as per The Rules of Golf.
9. Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and any Local Rules in force on the day.
10. Any disputes must be presented to the Proshop within 20 minutes of the final group submitting their score cards. The Proshop will rule on the dispute and this decision will be final.

11. The use of motorised carts is allowed.
12. Handicap allowance for the 27-hole nett competition is $\frac{3}{4}$ of the combined handicaps. i.e.:
Player A on 14 & Player B on 18 – handicap for 27 holes is $\frac{3}{4} \times 32 = 24$.

2026 MIXED FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

1. All players must be 7-day members of Riverlakes Golf at the time of the championships and must also hold a current GA handicap.
2. To qualify for participation in the Mixed Foursomes Championship, a member must have played a minimum of 5 Saturday Riverlakes Competition Golfink events during the preceding 12 months, independent of the Honour Board Events.
3. Teams are to be made up of two players – 1 male and 1 female.
4. The Championships are to be held over 27 holes to be played on Saturday, 28th March 2026
5. Men will tee off on the first hole and then alternate tee shots up to and including the 18th hole.
6. On the 19th tee, the players change the order of play, the ladies will tee off on the 1st hole. This change is mandatory. Failure to do this will cause the team to be disqualified from the competition.
7. In the event of a penalty, e.g., ball in hazard, the order of play does not change. If Player A hit the ball into the hazard, then Player B will play the next shot.
8. In the event of a tie, the Gross Championship will be decided by a “sudden death” playoff, starting at the 1st hole, followed by the 2nd hole etc. The order of play will be as per the first 18 holes. The Nett Championship will be decided by a countback as per The Rules of Golf.
9. Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and any Local Rules in force on the day.
10. Any disputes must be presented to the Proshop within 20 minutes of the final group submitting their score cards. The Proshop will rule on the dispute and this decision will be final.
11. The use of motorised carts is allowed.
12. Handicap allowance for the 27-hole nett competition is $\frac{3}{4}$ of the combined handicaps. i.e.:
Player A on 14 & Player B on 18 – handicap for 27 holes is $\frac{3}{4} \times 32 = 24$.

2026 GOBLET CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. This event is run as a 4BBB Handicap Matchplay event.
2. To qualify for participation in the Goblet, a member must have played a minimum of 5 Riverlakes Competition Golflink events during the preceding 12 months, independent of the Honour Board Events.
3. Players wishing to qualify for this event must place a "Q" on their card on the qualifying round.
4. Men's & Ladies Qualifying: 10th October.
5. Men: The best 16 scores qualify for the championship.
6. Ladies: The best 4 scores qualify for the championship.
7. Men's Round of 16 – 17th October
8. Quarter Finals Matchplay – Men – 24th October
9. Semi Finals Matchplay – Men & Ladies – 31st October
10. Finals Matchplay – Men & Ladies – 7th November
11. Players who qualify must be available to play on these dates. After Matchplay draw if finalised, replacements will not be allowed.
12. The Fourball Goblet will be a knock-out event with each round consisting of 18 holes. In the case of a match being halved at the end of 18 holes, the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off starting at the first tee and continuing until a hole is won (handicaps apply on extra holes).
13. Players use their current daily handicap for each day of play.
14. The lowest marker in the group of players reduces his or her handicap to scratch, all other players then reduce their handicap by the same number.
Example: Player A has a handicap of 9, Player B 15, Player C 18 and Player D 23. Player A deducts 9 and now plays off 0, Player B deducts 9 and now plays off 6, Player C deducts 9 and now plays off 9, Player D deducts 9 and now plays off 14
15. The Match Play Index is used to determine where the shots are given.
16. If one player from a team is not ready to start play at the prescribed time, their partner may start the match and continue until the player arrives or a result is achieved. Should a player arrive after the match has commenced, they may join the match at the start of the next hole that is being played.
17. Should both players from a team not be ready to start play at the prescribed time, they will forfeit the match.
18. The use of motorised carts and distance finding devices is allowed.
